BRIGHT FUTURES is HERE!! Effective immediately, all seniors should sign up for Bright Futures. The Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program is to reward students for their academic achievements during high school by providing funding to attend postsecondary education in Florida. This year, there are ***new requirements***: students are now required to submit a complete, FASFA in order to be eligible for Bright Futures (no FASFA = No \$). There is an increase in community service requirements for all three levels. For instructions on how to sign up for Bright Futures, please go to BRACE.
